Course Guide and Fees

Elementary Art \$ 150.00 per semester plus \$25 semester supply fee

Ages 6-7 and 8-9

The Art classes will introduce students to Art History, appreciation, and technique. Through the study of various artists, their influence on the art world and their technique students will begin to develop their own art skills.

The class will use elements of design to allow the observant student to draw or reproduce what they see. Contour line, color theory, shape, composition, and shade and value will be introduced and applied. A writing component will be an essential facet of the class. Student projects will be creative, imaginative, and fun.

Elementary Art \$150.00 p/s plus \$25 semester supply fee

Ages 10-11

The 10 and 11 year olds will begin an in-depth study of composition and drawing. Students will keep a sketchbook and journal (writing component). Three-dimensional work will be brought in at this level.

Elementary Spanish

\$150.00 per semester

This high-energy class with a hands-on approach makes the subject easily attainable. The methodology used in this class, Total Physical Response, engages the student immediately in the language.

Spanish I Ages 6-7 Greetings, numbers, colors, clothing, days, months, body parts, items in the classroom, house and stores; beginning sentence structure, conversation and holidays. Culture and traditions from various Spanish-speaking countries will be introduced.

Spanish II Ages 8-9 Includes vocabulary from Spanish I plus adjectives, food groups, weather, expressions, storytelling and acting, simple dialogue, conjunction of the most used verbs in the present tense form, asking questions and responding.

Spanish III Ages 10-11 Includes more vocabulary, reading, writing, comprehension, conjugation in present tense of commonly used verbs. Study of people that live in Spanish speaking countries, their daily lives, customs, and history.

The Magic of the Reading/Writing Connection Ages 6-9

\$150.00p/s

Students will be introduced to a variety of writing styles in tandem with the reading of children's literature. Students will learn the basics of sentence structure, paragraphing, construction of the composition (story mapping), rough draft, editing, final draft, grammar concepts, and vocabulary. These courses are an introduction to the creative writing process. The course will include, but not be limited to, material by Arnold Lobel, Jan Brett, Folk Tales, and Fairy Tales.

Elementary Music

\$150.00 per semester

Music Ages 6-8

Children learn about the basics of music through folk songs and singing games. Emphasis is placed on learning to sing in tune, as well as mastery of fundamental concepts like beat, rhythm, and beginning rhythmic and melodic notation.

Music Ages 9-11

\$150.00 per semester

Children enjoy folk songs, play parties, and singing games and use them to explore and master the fundamental elements of music literacy: learning to sing in-tune, notate basic rhythms and melodic figures, as well as use of movement in the classroom.

Handbell Choir Ages 9 & up

\$150.00 per semester

A new SVS children's handbell choir enables upper elementary children to learn music basics (rhythms, melodies) through the medium of a handbell ensemble. Handbell choir meets weekly.

Recorder Club Ages 8-11

\$150.00 per semester

In Recorder Club elementary children learn the basics of music literacy and ensemble music-making while learning to play the recorder. Recorders are provided at no charge for use during the course. If a student wishes to purchase his/her own recorder, sources can be recommended.

Physical Education Club

\$150.00 per semester

Ages 6-7, 8-9, and 10-11

The PE Club allows students to develop physical skills in a group setting. Students will be involved in earning the President's Physical Fitness Award as well as being introduced to fun group activities.

Library/Study Hall

Ages 6-11 \$125.00 per semester

Library/Study Hall allows the student to pursue recreational reading or research and fills in any gap time between classes.
